Students try to make pairs with present and past plurals by asking, "I have see. Do you have saw?"</p>	<p>Irregular Plurals Present/Past Tense DIRECTIONS # 2</p> <p>When student receives the requested card, he puts down the pair and asks again. If the other player does not have the requested card, he picks from the pile. If he picks his wish, he may go again.</p>	<p>Irregular Plurals Present/Past Tense DIRECTIONS #3</p> <p>If player does not receive his card, the play continues with the next player. If a player runs out of cards, he picks a card. The game ends when ALL cards have been picked and played. The player with the most pairs wins.</p>
