<p>Spelling Rule #1 *Change the -y to -i and add -es when adding an -s to a noun or verb that ends in a <u>consonant</u> + y: bunny + -s = bunnies cry + -s = cries</p>	<p>Spelling Rule #2 *Drop the silent e when adding -ed or -ing to a word ending in the CVCe pattern: tape + -ed = taped bite + -ing = biting</p>	<p>Spelling Rule #3 *Double the consonant when adding -ed or -ing to a word ending in the CVC pattern: hop + -ed = hopped trip + -ing = tripping</p>	<p>Spelling Rule #4 *Add -es to make the word plural in words ending in -ch, -sh, -s, -z, -x or in words ending in 'o'. switch<u>es</u> tax<u>es</u> to<u>es</u></p>
